

Treasurer Reports were given by Lion Tony Barry, Club Report and Lion Mary Frances Gosnell, Foundation Report. The reports were approved as presented.

Spring 2013 Damascus White Cane Days

Thank you, all Lions who participated in our Spring 2013 White Cane fundraiser. We raised \$1,773 (pure profit!). Combine that with our \$1,722 from last November and our total for the Damascus Lions Business Year 2012-2013 is \$3,495. Our last three collections have all been over \$1,700 which might tell us that the effect of the Great Recession in Damascus is now abating. Twenty-eight dedicated Damascus Lions performed storefront collections over thirty-one shifts during a sunny but cool week. Several big-hearted Lions worked multiple shifts to help us fill our schedule. Unfortunately, twenty-eight Lions are not quite enough, so seven shifts on the schedule were went unmanned.

Our new shifts at Safeway from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM were very busy and we will keep them for the future. Next fall, we will move a few Saturday shifts to later timeframes. Damascus shoppers aren't getting up as early on Saturday mornings as they used to do! Please think the word: "Lion" in front of every name in this article.
