June Board Minutes

The monthly Damascus Lions Club Board of Directors meeting was held at Gladhill Brothers, Damascus, MD. The meeting was called to order at 7 PM by King Lion Joy Schwab. Those Lions in attendance were Patsy McKenzie, Tessie Gladhill, Mary Frances Gosnell, John Washington, Marcia Holpuch, George Hibbard, Warren Schwab, Del Mayhew, Joy Schwab and Ray Molesworth. King Lion Joy appointed Ray Molesworth as the temporary secretary for the meeting. The minutes of the Board of Directors meeting on May 9, 2017 were approved as reported in the June 2017 Lions Tale. Lion Mary Frances Gosnell, Foundation Treasurer, reported the foundation assets as of 5/31/2017: Certificates of Deposit \$52,000.03; Foundation Checking account \$44,637.05 and Student loan outstanding balance of \$1,702.93. The Foundation Treasurer's report was approved as presented. Lion Del Mayhew, Club Treasurer, reported a balance of \$7,468.07 in the Damascus Lions Club administrative account as of 5/31/2017. The Club Treasurer's Report was approved by the Board as presented.

Old Business

A continuation of the discussion of the coming year's Foundation Budget was led by Foundation Treasurer Lion Mary Frances. The Board was previously provided with a copy of the proposed budget for review. A motion to approve the Foundation budget was made by Lion George with a second by Lion Del. The proposed 2017-2018 Foundation budget was approved by the Board of Directors as presented. (See Attached Foundation Budget)

Club Treasurer Lion Del presented the proposed administrative club budget for the year 2017-2018. The Board had previously been provided with a copy of the proposed budget for review. A motion was made to approve the Club budget as presented was made by Lion Marcia with a second by Lion John. The proposed club budget was approved by the Board of Directors as presented. (See attached Club Budget)

The Club will participate in the "Celebrate Damascus", parade on July 7, 2017. The board decided to provide pencils in lieu of candy as giveaways during the parade. The club will also sponsor a pancake breakfast at the Damascus United Methodist Church on July 8 from 7AM until 11 AM. A flea market will be held at the Damascus United Methodist Church on July 8 in connection with "Celebrate Damascus".

Lion Tony Barry is coordinating a previously approved project to refurbish and maintain the Skate Park at the Damascus Community center. This project requires replacement of rotten boards and painting. This activity will take place on June 17, 2017 at the Damascus Community Center. An additional \$250 from the Foundation account was approved by the board to purchase and install a Lions Club sign at the Skate Park. The motion was made by Lion Marcia with a second by Lion Ray. Lions Marcia and Tony will follow up on the sign.

New Business

Lion Patsy has arranged a fund raiser with Ledo's in Damascus for June 27, 2017. The club will receive 20% of all sales that are made between 11AM and 9PM including carry out orders if the customer mentions the Damascus Lions Club. The regularly scheduled meeting on July 4th will be held at Ledo's on June 27 to coincide with the fund raiser. Lion Patsy is also researching the possibility of the Club having a "Big Money Bingo" as a fund raiser.

The board discussed a request from the Damascus Sports Association to contribute to the painting of the Damascus Hornets logo on the Damascus Water Tower that is currently being repainted by WSSC. A \$250 donation from the Foundation was approved for this request.

There will be no organized event at a Frederick Keys Baseball game this year.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15PM.
