Meeting called to order at 7:00PM

Prior meeting minutes approved with no revisions.

Treasurer's Report

Lion Del Mayhew presented the Treasurer's report and the foundation profit & loss statement prepared by Mary Frances Gosnell along with supporting bank statements. Both reports were approved as presented

Secretary's Report.

Joe Howerton read a letter received from Community Fair thanking the club for our support.

One member still has outstanding dues.

Committee: Sight Conservation 04/18 reported by Wayne Marr

• Five cases are in progress. If all five individuals see our vision providers, the cost to the club will be in the area of \$500-\$700

17/18 Budget - \$2,500

17/18 Expended to Date: \$793 (through Laura Mendoza; 7 cases)

Committee: White Cane 04/18

• We collected \$1,869.93 during our Spring White Cane fundraiser (April 25-28). Twenty-five Damascus Lions performed storefront collections over twenty-nine two-hour shifts. We averaged \$64.48 per shift; not a record, but on the high side. We will also collect at the Shredfest in May. This may add a few hundred dollars to our total.

17/18 Budget - \$4,000

17/18 Collected to Date: \$3,804.05 (October 2017 Collection plus April 2018 Collection)

New Business

Del Mayhew noted that new officer training is to be held at Leisure World. Marcia Holpuch will be sending names for officers registered for training.

It was suggested that the upcoming golf tournament be publicized in the Lion's Voice of 22c. Joe Howerton to share to local social media.

Peruvian Grill expressed interest in presenting at an upcoming dinner meeting to promote awareness of the restaurant. The owner has been supportive of the club by purchasing ad space for the pancake breakfast. Date not yet established.
